Chloe Cornhill (12) kept her cool, dominating her age group winning the top 12 year old girl trophy, by achieving 3 gold's in the 200 fly, 200 freestyle and 100 freestyle, and adding a further 2 silvers and 4 bronzes.



Megan Palmer (11) had huge success by winning top girl in her age group by grabbing gold in her 200 backstroke and 4 silvers including all her breaststroke distances and 100 freestyle. She also claimed a hat-trick of bronzes.
